MINUTES, SEPTEMBER 30, 2010

The School Board of Escambia County, Florida, convened in Special Meeting at 4:00 p.m., in the Board Room, at 215 West Garden Street, Pensacola, Florida, with the following present:

[General discussion among Board Members, the Superintendent, and staff occurred throughout this meeting.]

I. CALL TO ORDER/ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Mr. Boone called the Special Meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. The Superintendent listed the additions, deletions, and amendments that had been made to the agenda since its initial publication. (NOTE: At the September 17, 2010 Regular Workshop, Mrs. Waters stated that she would present a recommendation to the Board, to approve a contract appointing several law firms to represent the School Board in litigation against BP, for losses incurred by the School District due to the recent oil spill disaster.) Upon inquiry by Mrs. Hightower, Mrs. Waters advised that she had requested the deletion of Item II., Attorney Employment Contract Contingent Fee Agreement, as she had received phone calls and email messages indicating that some individuals felt she had "rushed" through the process of selecting law firms. Mr. Bergosh pointed out that the contract submitted by Mrs. Waters would have appointed four (4) out-of-town law firms to represent the School Board. Mr. Bergosh said he would not have supported a contract with any out-of-town firms until local firms had been considered. Mrs. Waters asked that anyone with concerns or questions about the selection process to please contact her. Mr. Bergosh noted that as a follow-up, he would submit the topic of "legal representation" as a discussion item for the October 14, 2010 Special Workshop.

1. Termination of the Grant Between the School Board of Escambia County, Florida and The Florida Bar Foundation Discipline Alternatives to Zero-Tolerance – Year 2

Motion was made by Mr. Slayton and seconded by Mr. Bergosh, to terminate the *Grant between the School Board of Escambia County, Florida and The Florida Bar Foundation, Discipline Alternatives to Zero-Tolerance – Year 2.* The Superintendent noted that the School District remained committed to the principles of Restorative Justice; however, programmatic concerns precluded the continuation of the Florida Bar Foundation program. Motion carried unanimously.
