MINUTES, SEPTEMBER 13, 2010

I. CALL TO ORDER/ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Mr. Boone called the Special Meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Motion by Mrs. Hightower, seconded by Mrs. Moultrie, to adopt the agenda, carried unanimously.

II. PRESENTATION OF 2010-2011 MILLAGE RATES AND DISTRICT SCHOOL BUDGET

[Documents outlining the 2010-2011 millage rates and District School budget (including resolutions 11-03, 11-04 & 11-05) are filed as Exhibit "A" in the Supplementary Minute Book.]

Mrs. Laura Shaud, Director of Budgeting, gave a brief presentation on millage rates and the District School budget for fiscal year 2010-2011. Her presentation included an explanation of the "rolled-back rate" and other information as required by the Truth-in-Millage (TRIM) Act.

Motion by Mr. Bergosh, seconded by Mrs. Moultrie, to adopt *Resolution Number 11-05*, was approved unanimously.
