### INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mrs. Hightower delivered the invocation and Mr. Bergosh led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

#### PUBLIC FORUM

Mr. Boone called for Public Forum at 5:35 p.m..

The following speaker requested to address the Board: (Supplementary Minute Book, Exhibit "A")

Mrs. Hightower suggested that the recommendation for the appointment of Rebecca McBride be amended by striking the descriptive term "corrective action" from the job title Administrator on Special Assignment-Corrective Action. She explained that the term "corrective action" had been included simply to describe the individual's specific assignment; however, the Board-approved job description for an Administrator on Special Assignment did not include such a term. She added that the amendment would allow for the Superintendent's recommendation to correctly reflect the actual title of the position. The Superintendent confirmed that he had no objection to the proposed amendment. Mrs. Hightower moved to amend the recommendation for the appointment of Rebecca McBride by striking the term "corrective action" from the job title Administrator on Special Assignment-Corrective Action. The motion to amend was seconded by Mr. Bergosh and approved unanimously.
