Mr. Bergosh requested that Item 5 (09-19-11 Special Meeting) be pulled from Section IV for separate vote. Motion was made by Mr. Bergosh and seconded by Mr. Slayton, to approve the minutes as listed (except Item IV.5, 09-19-11 Special Meeting). Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Mrs. Moultrie and seconded by Mr. Slayton, to approve Item IV.5, 09-19-11 Special Meeting. Mr. Bergosh reiterated comments he had made during the October 14, 2011 Regular Workshop regarding this particular item. He said that he would not support approval of the minutes from the September 19, 2011 Special Meeting as he did not believe that those minutes adequately reflected all of the discussion that occurred during that meeting. Upon inquiry by Mrs. Hightower, Mr. Bergosh said that he

had no suggestion for amending the minutes from the September 19, 2011 Special Meeting. By not supporting the approval of this particular set of minutes, Mr. Bergosh said he was trying to make the point that minutes do not always capture all of the discussion that occurred during a School Board workshop or meeting. Mr. Bergosh said he was hopeful that the School District would eventually move to a system where video from each School Board meeting or workshop was accessible via the School District's website and could be viewed by all who were interested. Motion carried 4 to 1, with Mr. Bergosh voting "No."

(\*At the request of Mr. Bergosh, Items V.A.2 through V.A.10 were pulled from the Consent Agenda for separate vote.) Motion was made by Mr. Slayton and seconded by Mrs. Moultrie, to approve Item V.A.2 through Item V.A.10. Mr. Bergosh noted that he had thoroughly expressed his concerns about these items during the October 14, 2011 Regular Workshop. He referred specifically to Section 20.a of the contracts which specified that SES providers were required to pay \$500 per school for routing buses, at schools at which SES providers operate, and that the School District would distribute those funds directly to the Transportation route managers. Mr. Bergosh agreed with charging the SES providers this \$500 fee, but disagreed with distributing those funds directly to Transportation route managers. Instead, he believed that the funds should be deposited to the School District's general fund. Mr. Bergosh said he would not support the motion to approve these items because of a "philosophical disagreement" with giving additional monetary compensation to salaried employees, whose work hours were not specified by any collective bargaining agreement, and therefore, could be required to work overtime without additional compensation. Motion was approved 4 to 1, with Mr. Bergosh voting "No.".
