JOB SUMMARY

The purpose of this position is to perform a wide variety of skilled installation, maintenance, and repair work to locking mechanisms, door closures, panic hardware, doorstops, and door hold devices.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Performs routine and complex maintenance, repair, and installation work on door closures, panic hardware, manual and electronic doors, hinges, doorstops, and door hold devices; Coordinates and instructs the work of skilled trades assistants.
- Installs, repairs, and maintains manual and electronic locking systems, keys, and associated security access systems.
- Prepares duplicate keys using hand tools and specialized key cutting equipment;
 Rekeys locks up to and including level 6 keying systems.
- Repairs and replaces locks on safes, desks, drawers, and cabinets; Repairs and/or adjusts various gates/barriers and door closers; Hangs steel doors; installs panic hardware and door closers.
- Designs, fabricates, and installs various parts, e.g., mounts, pivots, latch guards.
- Disassembles door locks and panic hardware to repair or replace worn tumblers, springs, and other parts; Inserts new tumblers into lock to change core structure.
- Utilizes various basic and specialized tools to open locking mechanisms without appropriate keys or combinations; Changes combinations.
- Maintains various records and reports, e.g., maintains inventory of materials;
 Maintains all inventory records of master and grand master key systems throughout the School District.
- Orders appropriate door hardware.
- Communicates with District staff to respond to safety concerns regarding equipment, building security, project completion; Assists in the evaluation of new security and locking equipment.

- Performs all work in compliance with all applicable codes, standards, and regulatory requirements.
- Operates various automobiles and transport vehicles, e.g., car, utility truck, utility van.
- Conforms to safety standards as prescribed.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- High school diploma, GED, or other equivalent.
- Four (4) years of professional experience in maintenance and repair of commercial manual and electronic locking devices, door closures, panic hardware, doorstops, and door hold devices.
- An equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the essential functions of the job.
- Must possess and maintain a valid Driver License.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Requires the ability to display knowledge of tools, methods, materials, and techniques
 of the specialty area.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of practices, procedures, techniques, and methods of the locksmith trade.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of hand and power tools.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of standards, techniques, methods, practices, and tools of the trade.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of operation and care of power and hand tools and specialized equipment.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of applicable codes and regulations.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions.
- Requires the ability to display knowledge of basic arithmetic.
- Requires the ability to work with hand and power tools.
- Requires the ability to perform maintenance and repair tasks.
- Requires the ability to use or repair small/light equipment, such as power tools, and medium equipment and machinery, such as vehicles or commercial mowers.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

While performing the essential functions of this job the employee is regularly required to sit, stand, and walk, use hands to finger, handle, or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, and lift and/or move up to 100 pounds. The work also requires the following physical abilities in order to perform the essential job functions: repetitive motion, and visual acuity.

WORKING CONDITIONS
