JOB SUMMARY

The purpose of this position is to coordinate and oversee skilled work involving the maintenance and repair of diesel and gasoline driven motors and related auto equipment, machinery, and tools.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Coordinates repairs, preventative maintenance, and servicing of all automotive equipment; assigns work and projects to personnel and reviews project status.
- Inspects and performs repairs, preventative maintenance, and servicing of automotive equipment as needed.
- Supervises entry level and skilled trades workers in the absence of the assigned supervisor.
- Instructs and trains personnel and directs the accomplishment of unusual problems and activities.
- Reviews incoming maintenance requests and work orders to determine man-power, tools, equipment, and materials requirements and schedules work accordingly.
- Creates, tracks, and oversees the startup and completion of each work order.
- Requires the ability to act as a lead worker.
- Ensures all waste and hazardous materials are disposed of in accordance with prescribed safety policies and environmental procedures; Maintains cleanliness of painting facilities and equipment; Maintains inventory of materials.
- Reviews, prepares, and submits orders and requisitions for parts.
- Repairs and maintains tools and equipment.
- Performs various administrative duties, e.g., estimates time and materials for repairs, maintains appropriate repair logs and records; Maintains parts and equipment inventory records; inspection and other vehicle maintenance scheduling.

- Maintains various records and prepares reports, e.g., records work order logs, maintains inventory of materials, evaluates, and prepares cost estimates for various projects.

- Requires the ability to display knowledge of basic arithmetic.
- Requires the ability to perform maintenance and repair tasks.
- Requires the ability to communicate clearly and effectively orally and in writing.
- Requires the ability to utilize Microsoft Word and Excel to manage fleet maintenance.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

While performing the essential functions of this job the employee is regularly required to stand, use hands to finger, handle, or feel, reach with hands and arms and is frequently required to bend at the waist, stoop, or crouch and lift and/or move up to 50 pounds.
