Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 19. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student number 07-81-061 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2006-2007 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 20. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student number 07-83-851 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2006-2007 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 21. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student number 07-86-281, be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2006-2007 school year and all of the 2007-2008 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 22. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student number 07-88-1251, be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2006-2007 school year and all of the 2007-2008 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 3. Recommend that employee #2343-9640-8 be suspended without pay for three (3) working days beginning Tuesday, March 27, 2007, based on misconduct as more specifically identified in the notice letter to employee.
- 4. Recommend that employee #946652 be suspended without pay in accordance with the Return-to-Work Agreement dated Friday, February 23, 2007, effective Tuesday, March 27, 2007, until the employee fully complies with the Return-to-Work program and is approved to return to work.
- 5. Recommend that employee #935604 be suspended without pay in accordance with the Return-to-Work Agreement dated Tuesday, March 13, 2007, effective Tuesday, March 27, 2007 until the employee fully complies with the Return-to-Work program and is approved to return to work.
- 6. Recommend that employee #535590 be suspended without pay pending the disposition of criminal charges and/or the School District investigation of misconduct resulting from the criminal charges beginning Tuesday, March 27, 2007, as more specifically identified in the notice letter to employee.
