REQUIRED BY THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS:

1. Purchase Textbooks and L.A.B. Seat in cosmetology department (**\$293.00 +tax**).
2. Purchase 3 complete sets of SOLID BLACK SCRUBS (not sold at GSTC).
3. One pair of primarily black tennis shoes (leather or leather equivalent). Must cover entire foot. No open toed or open back shoes. This is a safeguard against chemical spills or sharp objects.
4. MANDATORY SCHOOL SUPPLIES:
 - 2 Combination locks
 - 3 ring binder
 - Plastic sheet protectors
 - Notebook paper
 - Pens & Pencils
 - Ear buds/headphones. (Used with L.A.B. during computer-based learning ONLY, Not permitted during student salon hours, when clients are present or during Instructor Led class time.)

OPTIONAL SCHOOL SUPPLIES (highly recommended but not mandatory):

- Laptop or Tablet with Keyboard (*Not Chromebook as that brand is not compatible with L.A.B our interactive learning site*).
- Black Plastic Portable Locking Toolbox, 30+ inches in height. Brands such as FAT MAX, Husky or Dewalt Toolboxes (Purchase at Lowes or Home Depot, *Additional combination lock must be purchased for use at school.*)

Pivot Point Cosmetology Kit includes: 3 Humanely Sourced, Human Hair Mannequins, Mannequin Stand, Cape, Apron, Shear Set (Hair Cutting Shears and Texturizing Shears – Please specify if you are LEFT HANDED), Wahl clippers, Peanut trimmers, Round Brushes, Stylist Brushes, Combs, Clips, Pivot Point Blow Dryer, Pivot Point Flat Iron and Marcel iron, nail care kit and Pivot Point Book Bag. Purchased in cosmetology department.
