

WELDING TECHNOLOGY SUPPLY LIST

Note: Some of the items in the Welding Technology book and tool list could be considered “consumable.” In other words, these items need to be replaced from time to time. Listed below are the items that need to be replaced most frequently, and the recommended approximate quantities that may be needed to complete the program. This list may or may not be all inclusive of the items that will need to be replaced during a student’s time in the welding class; however, a student should maintain his/her tools if a student wishes to make adequate progress in the class.

 - Cutting goggles with # 5 lens
 - 12” Square
